

This Charter of Membership formally acknowledges membership of *Smartlink* in the OECD/LEED Partners Club and its three consultative fora: the Forum on Cities and Regions; the Forum on Social Innovations and the Forum on Entrepreneurship.

By associating a wide network of national, regional and local government bodies, development agencies and NGOs, as well as grassroots organisations and voluntary institutions and foundations with LEED work on a continuing basis, the Partners' Club extends the influence of LEED policies and approaches and attracts public and financial support. To help promote and stimulate the dialogue between LEED Partners and Delegates, the Chairs of the three consultative fora are often invited - with other LEED Partners -- to attend meetings of the LEED Directing Committee to present initiatives that may be of particular interest to the Committee. And meetings of the fora are often scheduled to coincide with meetings of the LEED Directing Committee in order to create further opportunities for collaboration.

Membership of the club also automatically confers the following benefits:

- . invitations to attend as observers international conferences and seminars organised by the Programme;
- . access to the expertise of LEED Programme staff working in the fields of entrepreneurship and local economic development;
- . access to LEED's own network of international experts;
- . specialised counselling services on improving contacts with national and regional organisations;
- . free distribution of LEED Programme publications;
- . availability of all other OECD publications at discount prices.
- . free distribution of LEED Flash and LEED-on-Line.
